- Host Clubs:** *Sailing World* and the Annapolis Yacht Club are co-organizing authorities for this regatta, an Official US SAILING sanctioned event. Annapolis Yacht Club is the Host Club and will provide race management, assisted by Eastport Yacht Club and Severn Sailing Association.
- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, will be replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*" Boats are urged to refrain from displaying advertisements for businesses or products competing with those of event sponsors.
- Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes whose owner and/or skipper is a current member of their National Authority (US Sailing Association for the USA):

- The organizing authority may add additional classes having at least six (6) entries.
- Entry Fee:** Up to 24 feet - \$195; 25 to 30 feet - \$230; 31 to 40 feet - \$265.
- Registration:** A representative of each boat must report to the Annapolis Yacht Club Junior Fleet Building at the AYC Annex, Thursday 28 April 2016 between 1700 and 1930. Crew List and Waiver of Liability signed by each crewmember must be submitted by the time of registration. No boat may compete without completed waiver form. In the event of crew substitution during the regatta, the new crewmember must submit a signed waiver to the Race Committee prior to racing for that boat's entry to remain valid.
- Schedule:** Ten races using drop-mark courses are scheduled. Rendezvous at the locations specified in the Event Sailing Instructions at 1000 each day. The first warning signal will be at 1100. No warning signal will be made after 1430 on Sunday 01 May 2016.
- Documents:** The Notice of Race and Event Sailing instructions will be available on the NOOD website <http://www.sailingworld.com/nood-regattas/annapolis>. Amendments to the Event Sailing Instructions and Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Annapolis Yacht Club Junior Fleet Building at the AYC Annex.
- Awards:** Prizes will be awarded by class.
